Hello Dalveen parents & community members!

Welcome to our Week 5 newsletter—it is hard to believe, but we are now almost half way through Term 3! Book Week, along with other special events are fast approaching, so please check the calendar for news and important updates.

Curriculum:

Students are working towards completing the drafts of their 'adventure narratives' and are including elements such as a "Sizzling Start", with the goal being to 'hook' the reader and introducing their characters and setting using figurative language and descriptive sentences. The P-2 students have completed their first Math Investigation for the Term called "Treasure Hunt" where they had to construct their own games. They are now revising some number concepts including strategies for addition and subtraction. This week, students also learned about the Leaning Tower Pisa, located in Italy, Europe and have been constructing their very own leaning towers in Art. This was also a STEM challenge and students enjoyed thinking of creative ways to get their towers leaning.

Science Week:

Science Week is being held next week with the theme being "Glass—more than meets the eye". We will be having a full day of Science and STEM, with Mr McGahey joining us for the day as we get involved with fun, engaging hands on experiments.

Book Week:

Our Book Week event is also looming and will be held on Tuesday 23rd October. We will be having a shared lunch on this day and students are asked to bring in a small plate of 'lunch' food to share. Sandwiches, fruit and hot finger foods are all good options. We are looking forward to seeing everyone dressed up in their Book Week costumes and we will be starting our celebrations with a special Book Week Parade as we meet all of our 'characters'.


