- 100% of 'at risk' learners receiving targeted literacy support

Our initiatives include

- Collaboratively develop a systematic, school-wide approach towards the teaching of writing across key learning areas
- Develop and participate in consistent, school-wide writing moderation practices aligned with the before, after, after, end approach, whilst engaging with cluster schools
- Timetable intervention and provide resourcing to support 'at risk' learners

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Developing staff capability in the teaching of writing through quality professional development, including Jolly Phonics and the STRIVE program (Travel \$700, Registrations & resources \$2251)
- Provide teacher release time for moderation (\$500)
- Employing a Learning Support Teacher Aide to assist with student learning support and literacy intervention (\$7000)
